





## Introduction:

Special Economic Zones are designed to encourage foreign investment and international trade, businesses operating within these Zones have no tax on their profits and are exempted from customs duties on imports and exports (capital goods, raw materials, construction materials, and office equipment) and import licensing requirements.

Now moving forward, they have advanced this initiative, which, while it does have similar attributes, it's far from being just Free Zones.
